

Year One - Things we are learning this week 15.04.24

Maths: We continue the important unit about composition of numbers from 11-19. We will use our knowledge of odds and evens in 0-10 to identify and reason about odd and even numbers between 10-19. The Year group then move on to doubling and halving numbers 6-10 and continue to embed those already learnt. Then we are using our knowledge of number pairs within 10 to solve addition and subtraction problems to 20.

Vocabulary: teen numbers, 11-19, tens, ones, odd, even, how many, addition, plus, more, equals, subtract, minus, different, same, doubles, half,

English: The children will be looking at our new text, "The Everywhere Bear" by Julia Donaldson, they will be writing questions, making predictions and writing a lost poster for the bear.

Phonics: Review Phase 5 GPCs for phonics screening check: *ay play, a-e shake, ea each, e he*

Spelling Words of the Week: *would, could, should, there*

PE: Team Building - To co-operate with a partner to complete a challenge. Sports Day Activity Scheme - To practise a range of sports day activities.
