English

Our focus in English will be story writing. The children will re-write the story of Croc and Bird in their own words. They are expected to include varied vocabulary (adjectives and adverbs), as well as using co-ordination (and, but, so) and subordination (even though, because, when, if).


Words of the week: carefully, kindly, quietly, eventually.

Our focus next week is addition but it will also include subtraction. This is because we are going to look at a variety of two-step problems. See the example below.


Twist It
