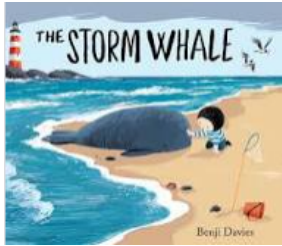


Weekly Learning Overview WC 02/10/23

English



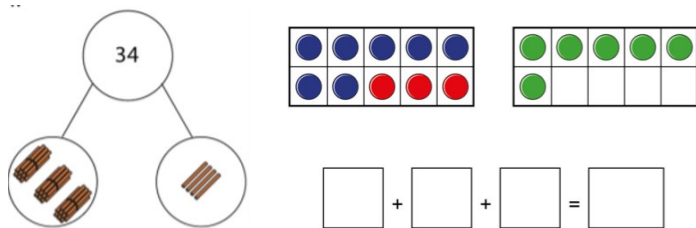
We can now reveal that our new text is *The Storm Whale* by Benji Davies. This wonderfully illustrated book tells us the story of a young boy, Noi, who rescues a little whale on the beach. We have already seen a huge leap in the maturity of the children's writing this week and the way in which they have explained loneliness and friendship. We're hoping for more of the same next week, when we discuss the qualities you find in a friend.

Words of the Week: find, kind, mind, behind.

Vocabulary: lonely, friendship, loneliness, kindness.

Maths

The children are going to continue composing numbers between 20 and 100. They will partition in different ways (see the model below), and they will start to manipulate the numbers with subtraction and addition stories. We will also look at odd and even – as this feeds into addition and subtraction – so the children will need to know these in order to be successful.



Vocabulary: first, next, then, partition, addition, subtraction, odd and even.

RE

The children will explore further representations of what God like for Christians.

Computing

The children have thought about IT around the school and next week will explore IT in the world.



Art

We are going to focus on drawing whales next week to go alongside our key text.



Science

Continuing the topic of *Animals including Humans*, the children will explore healthy eating, look at the different food groups and design a healthy plate.
