Our learning highlights this week.....

Year 2 have been learning about all the fantastic landmarks and tourist sites in our capital city. They have also been writing questions in English and putting the human life cycle in order in their Science learning.





In PSHE, Year 1 children learnt about a pupil's right to learn and what we can do to help each other be good learners. They have been doing lots of explaining in English and using the word 'because' to explain why they like their favourite toy. I enjoyed seeing pictures they had drawn of our beautiful world.

I had a wonderful time in Reception this morning in my first Head teacher assembly with them all.
