### Reminders

#### PE Kits

#### Year 1 and 2

PE kits need to be in school every day. Please check that their trainers fit well.

#### **Reception Children**

wear their PE kits all day on Friday and should wear them when they come into school at the beginning of that day.

Hair that falls below the shoulders must be tied back throughout the day.



**Jewellery** (except for small stud earring, watches and jewellery of religious significance such as Sikh bangles) must not be worn.

### Hair & Jewellery Scooters and Bikes

I know whizzing up the path to school or across the playground is fun, but please ask your child to dismount from their scooters and bikes as they enter the school grounds. This is a safety issue as there have been a couple of near misses this past week.



### **Play Trails**

Please do not allow your child to play with or on the outdoor equipment such as the play trails. Children must only use them if they are being supervised by school staff.

### Parent Helpers and Parent Safeguarding Talk

We really appreciate any additional support that parents are able to give in school - whether that be working with groups or individual pupils, helping out with PTA activities or chaperoning on a school trip. In order to do this, parents need to have a DBS check (Disclosure and Barring Service). There will be cost of £10 for this. Please speak to a member of staff in the office if you are new to the school or have not had one previously and would like to support us in this way.

As well as getting a DBS check, it is important that you also have some additional training on our specific safeguarding policies and practices. I will be holding parent safeguarding talks on Tuesday 19th September 9am – 9:30am and on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2:15pm – 2:45pm here at the school. There will also be an online talk on Monday 25th September at 6pm.

If you would like to attend either of these talks, please could you let the office know by phoning in on 020 8979 2945 to book a preferred date. There will be some reading to go alongside, which will send out to those who have booked on it via Parentmail two days prior to the meetings.
