## Principles of our Curriculum, Learning and Teaching

- 1. We believe in creating a stimulating learning environment that enables the child to develop an attitude of enquiry and independent learning.
- 2. We believe in promoting the 5Rs of Responsibility, Resilience, Resourcefulness, Reasoning and Reflection.
- 3. We believe children should develop as active, involved learners rather than as passive learners.
- 4. We believe children should be taught knowledge and concepts through exciting, meaningful and purposeful contexts
- 4. We believe in identifying and assessing children's learning needs and using this information to inform careful planning and differentiation to ensure the children achieve identified learning objectives.
- 5. We believe that effective teaching is facilitated by reflection and discussion of policy and practice by teachers, support staff, governors and parents.
- 6. We believe in teaching a broad and balanced curriculum to which every child is entitled, regardless of race, gender, ability or background.
- 7. We have high expectations of all of the children in our school and believe in making these explicit to all of the children and adults in our school.
